Deacon Glanzzy Moore Spain, Jr., 78, of Chase City, VA entered eternal rest on Monday, December 5, 2022 at his residence.

Deacon Spain was born March 30, 1944 in Farmville, VA to the late Glanzzy Moore, Sr. and Ernestine Williams Spain. He attended Thyne Elementary and the Historic Thyne Institute, and was a 1962 graduate of West End High School in Skipwith, VA. Deacon Spain earned his Associate Degree from Southside Virginia Community College in 1979. He joined Bluestone Baptist Church in 1954, and was ordained as a Deacon in 1973.
